

Inner Healing / Part 1

“Understanding the Wounded Soul”

The need for inner healing is necessary even if there is only one wounding.

A ministry of wholeness is not about counseling or clinical therapy but about quick intervention in people's lives. The result of this intervention is getting to the deep roots of where the initial wounding has taken place.

Most people you will minister deliverance to will have a demonic vulnerability due to the wound inflicted upon them when they were young.

IDENTITY IMPRINT

-the imprint of an identity at a formative point in life that causes you to lock into whatever was scripted for you.

LIFE SCRIPT

-a life script comes out of an identity imprint

It is critical for effective ministry to those that need inner healing to have a solid understanding of both **IDENTITY IMPRINTS, LIFE SCRIPTS & SOUL SCARS**

SOUL SCARS

-scar tissue is not ultimate healing. It is abandoned healing
-a scarred wound is not a wound that had been corrected

A life script is a plan and a program for your life that is

-not based on God's Word

-the result of some unfortunate incident or something that has been spoken into you that causes you to then script your life according to the event

Your identity imprint is your self perception of who you are

If a soul scar is not healed and corrected the result will be a repeat of the "life script"

Soul scars position you and make you vulnerable for the enemy to target you even more

When you are not walking in God's plan for your life you fall into Satan's plan for your life which is a false identity imprint

The power of Satan's identity imprint is stronger than your rational thought process

Right thinking is not an effective weapon when confronting the false identity imprint

If there is not intervention through deliverance and inner healing the same pattern will be repeated time and time again. This usually results in more wounds and more scars

WHO YOU ARE

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

ETYMOLOGY & ENTYMOLOGY

Etymology is the study of the origin of words and where they came from

The different aspects of who you are

SPIRIT

-the part of the man that is eternally reborn at salvation

Our spirit within us is the animating principle of life. Without the spirit within us there is nothing which is eternal

Our spirit is

-immaterial

-intelligent

-that which distinguishes you from all other living creatures

-the sentient part of who you are and the part of you that is immortal

SOUL

The soul is the seat of feelings, emotions, personality, and thoughts (our likes, dislikes, preferences)

The soul is the very actuating cause that motivates life. Without the soul there is not life

If Satan is successful at wounding the soul he has succeeded in wounding the real you

Sickness of the Soul

What is sickness of the soul?

3 ways the soul is wounded

1 Self Inflicted

- we are our own worst enemy
- the after math of the deeds we have done

2 Pain by proxy

- someone else did it, they have acted on your behalf and now you are feeling the effects
- S.P.O.A.
- generational curses

3 Injury by intent

- somebody sets out to damage you
- you are deliberately inflicted with a wound
- the intent usually comes from someone who themselves are sick

The pathology of soul wounding is that we become that which we have vowed to not become. This is abnormal psychology

We need to get down to the soul scars so that they can be healed. Jesus is the only one that can heal them to the point that a person is restored to the extent that the scar had never happened

Having the mindset to “just forget it and move on” is a huge mistake

The emotional scars and trauma are just as serious as the natural trauma
